

Minutes: Wayne County Planning Team-May 8, 2018

Absent: Roger Clark, Jim McNeil, Fr. Symon

The meeting started at 6:04pm

Deacon Bob led the Opening Prayer

Acceptance of the minutes for the last meeting: Motion by O'Connor, seconded by Owen

Shannon requested that the agenda be adjusted to review ministry assessments and building Sub Committee information go first and then the scenario evaluations. All agreed.

Wider communication needed to narrow down the choice.

Need a way to inform and get feedback from Parishioners.

Need to communicate with all the Parishioners. Decision was reached that Shannon would provide a) a list of Planning Team members; b) a short narrative on where we've been and where we are in the planning process; c) some priest data and d) map graphics of the remaining scenarios under consideration.

Intent was to provide this data to parishioners during the month of May/June . . . handouts, binders, bulletin information . . . at the discretion of the parishes. Ministry assessments could be handed out (with a roll-up of received data provided by the parishes) or taken on-line, with the "link" provided for in parish bulletins.

Ministry assessments would be open through June.
