General

The three churches in the Parish lie along the Route 104/Route 104A corridor. 92% of our parishioners reside between Lake Ontario and Route 104 (North of Route 104).

St. Thomas of Red Creek is in 6.5 miles from St. Mary Magdalene in Wolcott (Main Church and Rectory). St. Jude in Fair Haven is 5.1 miles from St. Thomas in Red Creek and therefore 11.6 miles from Wolcott.

Summer Community

The Catholic Community of the Blessed Trinity (CCBT) serves a large community of summer cottagers from mid-June through Labor Day. Cottagers along the waterfront from Fair Haven Bay west through Blind Sodus Bay, Port Bay and the Eastern and Southern ends of Great Sodus Bay are served by CCBT as well as by the churches of Saint Maximilian Kolbe Parish (St. Rose of Lima in Sodus Point and the Church of the Epiphany in Sodus). In terms of overall numbers, the summer community nearly eclipses the size of CCBT registered parishioners.

Migrant Workers

The area within the CCBT parish boundaries, astride Route 104 North to the Lake from Fair Haven West into the Eastern Ontario County (St. Maximilian Kolbe Parish) contains some of the largest apple farms in the state of New York. CCBT has a continuing relationship with local growers to visit migrant communities and assist them with needed clothing items via our relationship with the Wolcott Community Clothing Center. The contiguous (West to East) Towns of Huron, Sodus and Williamson (Parishes of Catholic Community of Blessed Trinity and Maximilian Kolbe) contain the largest number of migrant camps in the State of New York.

Committees and Social Outreach

CCBT is a very small parish. As a result we have no standing committees. Leadership for our social ministry, migrant and social outreach ministries . . . as well as others of like nature is usually only one deep. Leaders solicit the help and support of parishioners to execute all the programs that relate to community outreach and social ministry. We also, often, reach out to our closest neighbor, Kolbe Parish, to help us with information and guidance. The social ministry money assistance program (Social Outreach) is run by a volunteer.

Churches

St. Mary Magdalene, Wolcott is open year round. St. Thomas, Red Creek is open from mid-September to mid-June. In mid-June, St. Jude's opens to handle the influx of summer cottagers** and closes just after Labor Day. ** (In parallel with St. Mary Magdalene). In terms of church usage, most of our scheduled and other groups/activities meet at and utilize St. Mary Magdalene in Wolcott. A few of our main committees with rotate meetings between St. Mary Magdalene and St. Thomas but for the most part, St. Mary Magdalene handles the bulk of our activities. St. Thomas is the main center for the monthly Men's Group meetings and hosts periodic pancake breakfasts and well as special (ie Lenten) activities on a rotating basis with St. Mary Magdalene. Some baptisms, wedding and funeral take place at St. Thomas but the preponderance are held at St. Mary Magdalene. No activities or events, other than a single Mass on Sunday's in the summer, are held at St. Jude.

Seasonal Fluctuations

The Catholic Community of the Blessed Trinity is the smallest parish in Wayne County in terms of registered parishioners (one half the size of the next smallest, St. Joseph the Worker). Most of our parishioners (59%) are 55 years old or older. Beginning in late November and accelerating in December and early January, nearly 1/3 of our parishioners depart for Florida or other points South. As such, from November through mid-May, we have significantly depleted attendance. Parishioners return in mid-May and are followed by the arrival of summer cottagers and thus swell attendance. These sine wave-like fluctuations make planning difficult and diminish the level of community participation in programs or activities, especially from November through May.
